Q: Calculating derivative of a 3D vector Here is a picture of the initial setup: I'm trying to write a program that calculates the velocity of all arrows. Since the arrows are displayed as vectors, I thought I could simply use the dot product to calculate their velocity. Unfortunately, it turns out that the output of my program is not very accurate, not to mention the fact that I have to split each of my arrows into two components (One for the x-direction and one for the y-direction) which doesn't make much sense to me. I found a formula online, namely, where θ represents the angle between the vectors, γ is the angle between the first vector and the second vector, and d is the length of the first vector. The three components of the vector are given as follows: . . . (and so on, for each arrow in the middle). The angle between the first vector and the second vector is given as follows: I don't have any specific reason to use this particular formula, but it seems to work in my program. My question is this: Is this formula correct, or is it another formula for calculating the derivative of a vector? A: For a fixed t , I think the most natural way to obtain the derivative is to note that:
$$\frac{d\vec{v}}{dt} = \frac{\partial \vec{v}}{\partial t} + \dot{\vec{v}}$$
 where \vec{v} is any vector. Taking your arrows \vec{v} , and taking $t=0$, you are looking for the derivative of \vec{v} with respect to time, which is $\dot{\vec{v}}$. Your formula
